Immigration Poster

You and three others will be assigned to research an immigrant group to represent (Irish, Chinese, Japanese, Germans, Italians, Scandinavian, Jewish, and Mexicans).

You will be given a poster to present your research about an ethnic group that immigrated to America in the late 1800's to early 1900's.

You must have the following information:

- 1. Reasons why your immigrant group came to America.
- 2. Present a Timeline of important events in their immigration.
- 3. Where did they settle down in America? (you might have a map of the U.S. and label where they settled)
- 4. State at least 5 difficulties about settling in America.
- 5. 3 Quotes from immigrant group about life in America.
- 6. Statistics: How many came at different times? (create a graph)
- 7. State contributions of immigrant group to America's culture, e.g. food, clothes, architecture, famous people in politics, entertainment, etc.

Make your poster colorful and include some pictures of the immigrants. Use markers, pens, color pencils. Do not use pencil.
